# Evidence - Based Policy Making of Suicide Prevention Policy

It was decided that every municipality in Japan must develop their own local suicide countermeasure plan in FY2018 (Apr. 2018 – Mar. 2019), which allowed them to establish a system for promoting suicide countermeasures throughout Japan as the national minimum. The 3rd International Forum on Suicide Prevention Policy is designed to discuss how to accumulate the evidence for policy evaluation on suicide countermeasures. The Forum can also share the recent research outcomes on suicide countermeasures from the perspective of how it can be fed back to the society.

In the keynote lecture, Dr. Kim Doe Yoon, a vice director of Chungcheongnam-do Mental Health Welfare Center, will be invited to talk on advanced efforts against suicide countermeasures in the rural areas in Korea.

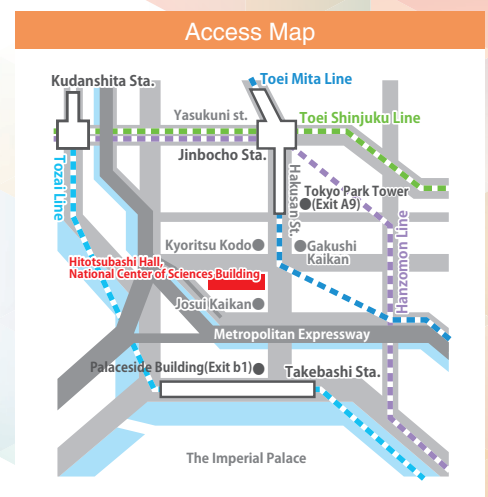
